Flu vaccines will be given to Miami county employees on Tuesday, **October 13th between 8am and noon at the Health Department.**

Once again, we will be taking donations for the Helping Hands. Please bring paper products, toothpaste, shampoos or soaps for the donations.

If you bring canned goods, please make sure they are not expired or damaged!

Our vaccines were made possible from a grant from the Dukes Health Care Foundations which was written last fall by our Health Department.

Drive thru at fairgrounds for Miami county residents age 18 and older will be **October 16th, 2015 from 9am until 2pm** or until supplies are depleted. All donations will go to Helping Hands on that day.

Walk ins for ages 18 and older will be given at my office, 35 Court Street on **October 20th** from 9am until 2pm or until supplies are depleted.

Canned goods and paper goods on that day will be donated to the Salvation Army. Again for all Miami county residents 18 years and older.

Children's flu vaccines are provided by the State of Indiana **not by grant monies.**

Children 6 months up to age 18 will be given flu vaccines at 35 Court St. on October 23rd and October 30th from 8am until noon. Walk in, no appointment needed! State guidelines are: child must have Medicaid, NO insurance or the Insurance that does NOT cover vaccines.
